This luxe Chinese from former Mr Chow chef, Philippe Chow (no relation), showcases linen-draped tables set with Wedgwood flatware, chopsticks neatly stored in wooden boxes, and celebrity sightings. The support staff pairs white jackets and mandarin collar uniforms with red canvas sneakers—this whimsical departure from formality is juxtaposed by the stately monochromatic color scheme of deep brown with light accents that flows throughout the multi-room space.

The satisfying menu carries dumplings, satays, and lettuce wraps, alongside main courses such as Beijing chicken dressed with walnuts and sweet brown sauce, that are sized for sharing. Lunchtime is a good chance to experience Philippe solo, when the popular prix-fixe is available.
